IIMC Activities Report 2020-2021

The following are activities organised by IIMC under IQAC during 2020-2021

1. Call for e-Papers 10-06-2020:

In the wake of the Corona virus pandemic, India's moment of crisis is causing a ripple effect across the global economy. From a broad perspective, the intertwining of the global economy in the age of complex, information-driven supply chains result in chain reactions that disproportionately affect certain industries. We have sent the brochure to all the colleges and Universities across the country and requested the Contributors to send their original research papers (unpublished), case studies and results of surveys on any of the topics or any other themes relevant to the main theme. We have received 64 research papers. These research papers were scrutinized by the review committee, subject to plagiarism and double-blind peer review. The editorial board members decided to publish 31 papers in the Journal of IIMC with ISN. The first three best papers were given the cash awards, along with e- certificates.

2. Preparing the careers in the post Covid world: 18-06-2020

A webinar was organized by IIMC in association with StratadigmPvt.Ltd. Sri Rajan, explained about various career opportunities to the final year students of all the streams.

3. Webinar on Yoga: 21-06-2020

Sri M.Satyanarayana, NSS Program Officer organized a session on "Yoga at Home" for the IIMCians through online. He explained that the purpose of yoga is to build strength, awareness and harmony in both the mind and body. While there are more than 100 different types or schools of yoga, most sessions typically include breathing exercises, meditation and assuming postures (sometimes called asana or poses) that stretch and flex various muscle groups. Yoga can eb very effective in developing managerial skills and reaching a more positive outlook on life.
