


## Code of Ethics to The Principal

- The Principal has the responsibility to deliver leadership, direction and co-ordination within the College.
- The Principal has to assure the competence and effectiveness in the whole of administrative plans and assignments.
- Administration of the academic programmes of the College as well the general administration of the College has to be under the purview of the Principal.
- The Principal should ensure that the development plans of the College, both long-term and short-term, with respect to the academic programmes are duly processed and implemented through relevant authorities, committees and its members.
- It is the responsibility of the Principal to ensure that observance of the acts, ordinances, regulations, rules and other orders issued by the University authorities, other regulatory bodies and the Management, from time to time.
- As the head of College, the Principal has the responsibility of addressing and resolving all issues concerned with the partakers of education.
- With regard to the disciplinary measures, the Principal has the authority to take all the necessary actions as per the direction of the regulatory authority. In this regard he/she should take actions, which should be impartial and he/she should maintain complete transparency.
- Principal has the responsibility for the smooth conduct of curricular, co-curricular and extra-curricular activities of the College.
- The Principal has the responsibility to ensure that ample importance is given to the gender sensitivity measures in all the activities of the College.
- Monitor, manage and educate the administration of the institution and take remedial actions based on the stakeholder's feedback.
- The Principal stands as a bridge between the Management and staff of the institution.
