The glory of 50 years has not achieved in a day, rather, the past glory set up by founders of the college in all these years nurtured the students through top quality education, using effective teaching methods in an affable and congenial environment.

Sri Kothuri Seethaiah Gupta, founder of the college was a great visionary and philanthropist. Under his able guidance, IIMC was established in 1973. Sri Challa Somraj Ram, Founder Secretary of the college has contributed an exemplary service to the institution till his last breath. Later, his son Sri Challa Prasanna has become Hon.Secretary & Correspondent.

A strong foundation was laid by the former Principals, Sri K.V.Gopala Swamy (1973-78) served the institution as the First Principal. He was the Registrar of Andhra University, Vishakapatnam.

Sri Raghavendra Rao served the institution as Principal for a period of 4 months (July-Oct'1978). He was the Head, Dept.of Commerce in Osmania University.

Sri P.Purnachander Rao served as Principal from 1978 to 1979.

Sri M.K.Subramaniam worked as Principal from 1979 to 1982. He was one of the directors of IIM, Ahmedabad. Due to his efforts IIMC got Government Aid, w.e.f.1980.

Sri P.Purnachander Rao served as Principal for a period of 15 years (1982-1997). During his tenure, B.Com (Computers) at U.G. level and M.Com at P.G.level were introduced.

Sri V.V.Ramana Murthy, worked as Principal for a period of 12 years (1997-2009). During his tenure B.Sc. (MSCs) was introduced. The Self Study Report (SSR) of 1st Cycle was submitted to NAAC during his tenure.

In 2009 Sri K.Raghu Veer has taken the charge as Principal. During his tenure, B.Com (Computer Applications) and BBA courses were newly started at U.G.Level as well as additional sections of B.Com (Hons.) and BBA were introduced. National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) 1st, 2nd and 3rd Cycles were completed successfully and Re-accredited by NAAC with A+ grade.

IIMC organizes various programmes and events through the committees. College has been conducting more than 130 programmes in every academic year for the overall development of students and the faculty members.

College organizes Inter-Collegiate events and allow students of other colleges to participate and explore their talent. IIMC publishes College Prospectus, “Campus Pulse” News Letter, “Pragyna” Magazine and Journal with ISSN. And also Add-on certificate courses.

Placements at IIMC have been conducted by offering orientation programme. The students aspiring for the placements are facilitated with Campus Recruitment Training (CRT). The students will be trained by Stratadigm Education and Training Pvt. Ltd. 57 MNC's visited the college for placements.



NAAC RE-ACCREDITATION (3RD CYCLE)

National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) is an autonomous body funded by the University Grants Commission and headquartered in Bangalore, which assesses and accredits Higher Education Institutions (HEIs). It is an outcome of the recommendations of the National Policy in Education (1986) which laid special emphasis on upholding the quality of higher education in India. NAAC accreditation is generally at the institutional level, assessing the performance based on various parameters categorized into 7 criteria.

NAAC's mandate includes the task of performance evaluation, assessment and accreditation of universities and colleges in the country. The philosophy of NAAC is based on objective and continuous improvement rather than being punitive or judgmental, so that all institutions of higher learning are empowered to maximize their resources, opportunities and capabilities. An institution's "Quality Status" is primarily determined through assessment and accreditation. Higher Education Institutions (HEI) receive accreditation scores when they meet the NAAC quality standards for institutes, colleges and universities.

Indian Institute of Management and Commerce has accredited by NAAC thrice. During the first cycle in 2010, the college has secured 'B' Grade, Second cycle with 'B++' in 2017 and in third cycle secured 'A+' grade recently, i.e. 2023.

19. Students are not authorized to collect donations from the fellow students for any of the college activity, without the permission of the Principal. On identifying any such unethical practices, action will be initiated.
20. It is mandatory for students to put not less than 75% of attendance in lectures (and practicals wherever applicable). On the specific recommendations of the Principal/Vice-Principals, the Vice-Chancellor may condone the shortage of attendance to the extent of 10% on medical grounds subject to the production of a Medical Certificate (MC) and the payment of prescribed condonation fee. Any candidate having less than the required attendance even after submitting the MC will not be permitted to appear for the University Examination. Every month the statement of attendance will be displayed on the notice board and uploaded on college website. Students and parents should take note of the attendance.




