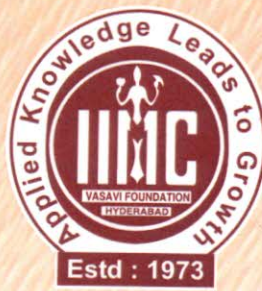

While referring to the subject and references cited, I am by direction to inform that the the Telangana State Council of Higher Education vide reference 1st cited addressed a letter to the Vice-Chancellors of Six Conventional Universities enclosing the D.O.Lr.No.TSCHE/Re-organization of Curriculum/2018, dt.17.05.2018 to place the same before the Deans/BOS/ Principals and suggest changes so as to finalize the syllabus for implementation w.e.f the Academic year 2019-20. The Six Conventional Universities submitted their views to the Council.

In view of the above, the Telangana State Council of Higher Education placed the said views in the Vice-Chancellors meeting held on 2nd May 2019 for discussion and as a follow up of the discussions a Meeting was held with the Subject Experts /Deans/Registrars of Six Conventional Universities on 10th May 2019 to discuss and finalize the templates of curriculum(CBCS) for implementation from the A.Y 2019-20. The following are the recommendations:

I. Reorganization of CBCS structure in Undergraduate courses in six conventional State Universities of Telangana:

a. Languages:

It was resolved to restructure the curriculum framework of the Languages so as to spread languages into 6 semesters with 20 Credits (2 courses with (4 credits) and 4 courses with (3 credits).

b. **Optional Subjects:**

It was resolved to have only 6 courses (one in each of 6 semester) of 5 credits each for each of the three optional for B.A., B.Com & B.Sc.

Further, a Generic Elective (open Stream) of 4 credits in 5th Semester and **Project work/optional** of 4 credits in 6th semester.

c. **AECC and SEC**

Ability Enhancement Compulsory Course (AECC) and Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC) as given in Annexure-I

d. **NCC/NSS/sports/Extra Curricular:**

Two credits will be given for NCC/NSS activities in a year.

For participating in inter University Sports/Extra Curricular in a year, 1 extra credit will be given. For participating in National/International events of recognised Sports/Extra Curricular in a year 2 extra credits will be given.

These credits will be Non-CGPA Credits and maximum of 2 credits can be earned in a year in one or combination of the above.

e. **Summer Internship:**

For doing at least 6 weeks of approved summer internship after 1st year or 2nd year, 2 credits will be awarded per internship.

f. **Credits:**

As per the recommended CBCS structure in **Annexure-I** (enclosed) there shall be 25 credits in each semester and a total of 150 credits for the UG programme.

II. Reorganization of Grading system:

The six conventional State Universities of Telangana are requested to adopt the Grading system for the A.Y.2019-20 as per **Annexure-II** (enclosed)

III. In B.Com courses the combinations to be offered from the A.Y 2019-20 in six conventional State Universities of Telangana.

- i) B.Com.
- ii) B.Com (Computer Applications)
- iii) B.Com. (Advertising & Sales Management)
- iv) B.Com. (Tax procedures)
- v) B.Com. (Foreign Trade)
- vi) B.Com. (Hons)

Further resolved for renaming of the existing B.Com (Computers) and B.Com (Ecommerce) course as B.Com (Computer Applications) from the Academic year 2019-20 in six conventional Sate Universities of Telangana.

IV Backlog Exams:

Regarding examination schedule it was resolved to conduct a meeting with the Registrars and Controller of Examinations of six conventional State Universities of Telangana.

Against this background, I am by direction to request the Registrars of the concern Universities to take immediate further necessary action as per rules in vogue to implement the above recommendations in all the Colleges (affiliated/ autonomous) under your jurisdiction from the Academic year 2019-20
