1. A Two Day Virtual National Conference on 'Research Challenges in the Digital Era'

Date: 18th & 19th December, 2020 **Time:** 12.30pm.- 5pm.

Report on Conference:

A Multi-Disciplinary National Virtual conference was organized on 'Research Challenges in the Digital Era' for two days in Google meet. The Convener welcomed the gathering and instructed the participants about the etiquettes of presentation in the online platform. Sri K.Raghu Veer, Principal gave the opening remarks. The Key note Speaker, Prof. A.Sudhakar, Director, SSIM was introduced to the audience by Dr.T.Naga Lakshmi, Vice- Principal (Academic). Day-01:

As the answer was humans create 25quintillions of data every day .He discussed the types of data, uses of data, job roles through data and some more. The first day went with some excitement and good feeling, as they were exposed to new terms and knowledge for the students.

Day-02:

On the second day, the resource person discussed on the Descriptive analysis, Diagnostic analysis, Predictive analysis and Prescriptive analysis. ways. Finally, he discussed the domain, its usefulness by applying the Business tools.
