- 2. The Candidates must write the Examination in their allotted centers only. The College Principals/ Chief Superintendents should not allow other center candidates under any circumstances
- 3. Candidates whose forms are rejected by the Examination Branch will not be considered. If any candidate is found not eligible at a later stage his/her registration will be cancelled for this examination.

- 4. The responsibility of obtaining correct question paper from the Invigilator at the Examination hall rests with the Candidate. Answering a wrong question paper may lead to cancellation of result.
- 5. Mobile Phones , programmable calculators and other electronic gadgets are strictly not allowed in to the Examination Hall.
