Parents

- 6. Parent/ Guardian have to accompany the student for any academic or other related matters of the college. Parents should contact Principal/ Vice- Principal with prior appointment only.
- 7. Direct Telephonic conversation with the authorities is not entertained.
- 8. Parents have to visit our college website regularly.www.iimchyderabad.com.
- 9. The Parents have to participate in the activities conducted by the college, as they are also one among the prime stakeholders.
- 10. If your ward is suffering from sickness or long term ailment, Parent/ Guardian should inform the Class Mentor immediately. Failing which the college authorities are not responsible for the shortage of attendance.
