

Peer Review Process

1. All the papers received will be submitted to peer review committee.
2. Each paper will be reviewed by two referees. They can be either external or members of the Advisory Board, though always chosen by their recognized expertise.
3. After evaluation, the reviewers will produce reports about the works reviewed, by which the papers can be
 - a) Accepted with modifications
 - b) Approved as they are
 - c) Rejected from the start
4. If the paper needs modifications, the editors will return the articles, to the authors along with reviewers suggestions/comments and recommendations there in.
5. The final decision concerning the publication of papers belongs to the Editorial Board, having the reviewers a consultative role.
