The elections were conducted to constitute office bearers of VFSWA. A new team was elected by the staff members in a unanimous way.




103. Entrepreneurship Skills: 23.04.2021

# 107. Voice4Girls Internships: 10.05.2021






110. Spectra force Technologies Internships: 20.05.2021
